1. Boot Camp Progress	S. Lowry H. Williams	Susan opened the meeting, saying there are some asks and some progress to report. The "Boot Camp" will not be called that, it will be called the Academic Bridge to College (ABC). With LaDonna's help we came up with a way to legally hold places in English 101 and Math 115 or 128 (college level classes). This year it depends on how the students are captured. At the Student Success Kickoff they will be pulled from the FYE cohort, which makes them a cohort. Next year when we try to expand we will need to think of other ways. They still need to talk to Wade about only being able to assess twice. Susan and Heidi will be talking to him on Thursday.

		Basic Skills will have a table at the Student Success Kickoff next week, Susan asked for volunteers to sit at the table. There was discussion about the flyer. Michele will show Susan and Heidi how to work with Google Docs to use for student sign-ups. They are proposing that we offer a 6-day program, August 4 and August 7-11. It was suggested that we could possibly do a Save the Date.
		There was discussion about how to manage the program. Susan suggested 100 students in cohorts of 25. They would be assessed on the first day. The next days they would rotate between English, Math, Reading and a fourth section. There was some brainstorming on what that fourth section could be. Some suggestions were: ESL, HD 103, Other HD classes, Avid strategies, managing test anxiety. The model will be approximately 6 hours. Some students will not be able to rotate to all subjects because of their assessments. There was agreement that there should be two instructors per class and at least one imbedded tutor.
		Michele raise a question that came up in another meeting about whether we would be competing with other summer programs for participants. Would they attend one or the other, or would they attend both? Susan answered that this would be very specific for nearly college-level ready. There needs to be differentiation. The whole program will need to be completed by August 13, which is when registration begins.

	Jane asked about how long the classes will be, they will need that information to start developing curriculum. They are not definite yet, but discussed 1-1/2 hours for four days.
