## What can I do with this major: Radiologic Technology

Radiologic technologists, also known as *radiographers*, perform x rays and other diagnostic imaging examinations on patients. Radiologic Technologists are educated to perform diagnostic imaging. They learn to position patients for x-ray exams, provide radiation safety for patients and others, and produce a quality diagnostic image. With additional training, Radiologic Technologists can specialize in various procedures and exam modalities. Radiologic Technologists must pass a national certification exam and receive a certificate from the State of California in order to practice. To maintain their certificates, Radiologic Technologists must complete 24 hours of continuing education every two years. The Antelope Valley College Radiologic Technology program provides concurrent didactic and clinical education. The program length is 24 months.
