Finding (Spring 2012) - Achievement Target: **Met**

80% of the students measured (116/145) meet the 70% student achievement criteria.

Finding (Fall 2012) - Achievement Target: **Met**

84% of the students measured (65/77) meet the 70% student achievement criteria.

Finding (Fall 2011) - Achievement Target: **Not Met**

55% of the students measured (50/92) meet the 70% student achievement criteria.
