3.2 ASO Events

Last day to register to vote for the Board of Trustees election for November 5, 2013 is October 21, 2013. ASACC conference will be held in New Orleans from Friday, November 8, 2013 through Sunday, November 10, 2013. The current total cost for attendance is \$1,732.54 per student who would be attending. ASACC is a national conference for student leaders. In order to attend you must write a 500 word essay before and after attending the conference. If you do not write the 500 word essay and turn it in within a week after the conference you will be required to pay back the full amount of the trip. Students would fly out early Friday morning and return Sunday evening.

Moved to approve an up to budget of \$25,000 to cover the total cost of attendance for the ASACC conference in New Orleans, LA out of the Student Representative Fee budget by Giovanna Sanchez, seconded by Shyann Blanco. Motion passed 8/0/0.

The plan is to have an emcee in the Library Plaza that Monday announcing events that will be taking place on campus throughout the week and playing music.
