Guided Pathways is a structure to provide all students with clear enrollment avenues, course-taking patterns, and support services. This framework centers the student experience in system-wide decision making and helps us meet the goals of the [Vision for Success](#) and [Call to Action](#).



## The Four Pillars of Guided Pathways

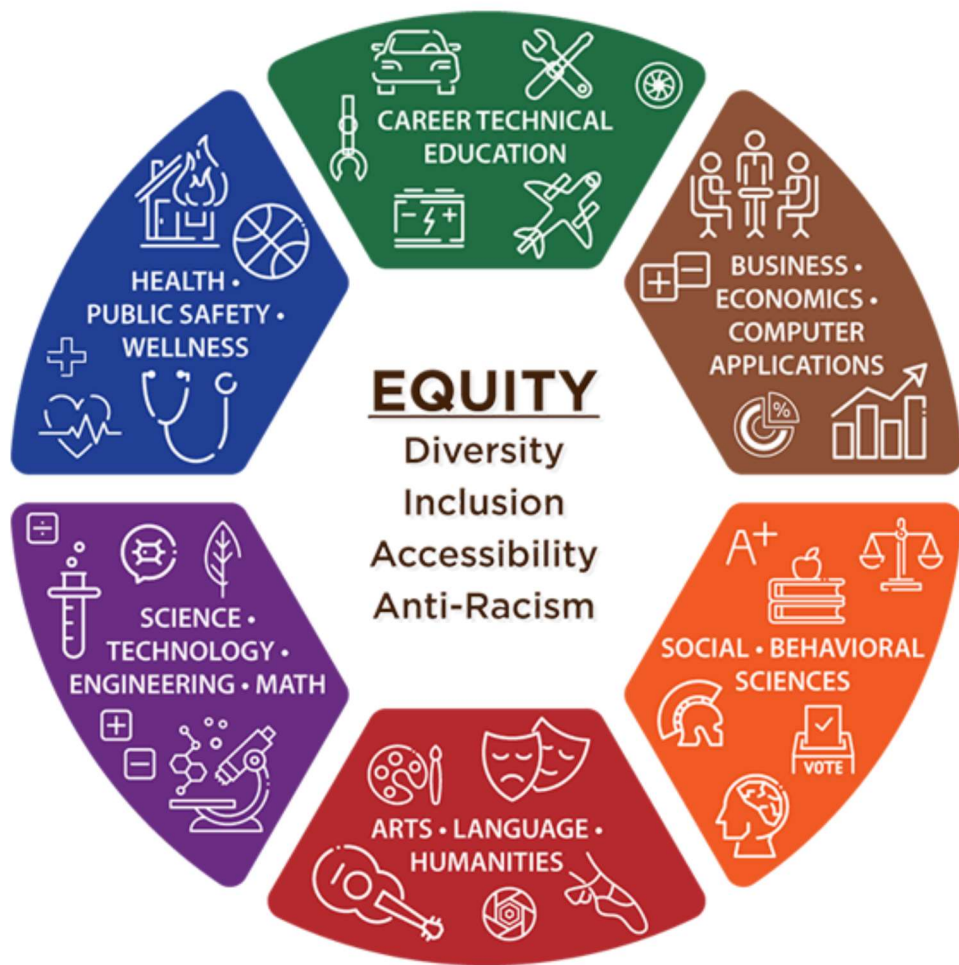
The "Four Pillars of Guided Pathways" are a framework designed to enhance student success and streamline the educational journey in higher education. These pillars provide a structured approach to help students navigate their academic path effectively. Here are the four pillars of Guided Pathways:

**First Pillar:** Clarify the Path (Career Exploration, Setting Goals, and Finding Programs)

**Second Pillar:** Enter the Path (Individually Customized Pathway, Prescriptive Task-based Advising, and Intelligent Resource Recommendations)

**Third Pillar:** Stay on the Path (Visual Progress Dashboard, Nudges & Reminders, Community-based Support, and Student Help-Desk)

**Fourth Pillar:** Ensure Learning (Analytics, Data Warehouse, and Built for Deeper Integration with College Systems)



## Areas of Study

What are Areas of Study?

Areas of Study are collections of academic majors (degrees and certificates) within a career area that have related courses.

Understanding students Areas of Study will help students choose a major and degree based on their interests, knowledge, skills, and abilities.





## **UPCOMING: Student Success Teams**

The purpose of the Student Success Team is to increase collegiality among faculty, classified staff, students, etc. to increase retention, persistence, and success outcomes among disproportionately impacted students.
