However, you will still be responsible for paying the enrollment fees for these two courses which are covered by financial aid if you are eligible. To receive the full benefits of the Triumph Scholars Program, you must maintain enrollment and satisfactory progress in both academic courses (ENGL 099 and HD 101), attend academic counseling sessions, and participate in student support services sessions as advised.
