We may run into some issues with the specific language in the TMC and what was entered in the course blocks. Discussion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Discipline list 	<p><i>Scott Lee</i></p>	<p>Issue Discussed:</p> <p>The issue we're looking at with the disciplines list is, in some cases when a course is being developed and it's in a new area, people are inventing new disciplines which haven't been recognized by the state. The Disciplines List comes from the Chancellor's Office and it's made up of minimum qualifications. We have had that happen with a few courses so technically no one is qualified to teach it because there are no minimum qualifications defined. We need to make sure we are double checking this in the workflow to verify the correct discipline is being selected.</p>
