Only 12 faculty members will be chosen for the committees, but these surveys are the way to have your voice heard. The Canvas shell is now on our AP&P webpage. Requisites: We have some major courses changing because of CCN. Do not send back workflows that have the CCN courses as requisites. We may change them later.
VII.	Training AP&P Course Review	Dr. Jonathan Compton	 AP&P Course Review: The orange box is an indicator that a section has changed. Make sure when you are reviewing under your AP&P rep role that you are looking at those changes. As far as non-substantial workflows, the Specifications tab should be the only area that has changes. Rationales are not needed for methods of instruction unless you choose "other". Assignment hours should be equal to the out of class hours. Methods of evaluation, must have at least the objectives listed but could include a rationale. Materials fee-if there is one, then it must be in this section and in the course description. These fees are due at the time of registration. Equipment is other items that need to be purchased by the student but amounts are not listed.
