## ABOUT THIS MAJOR

The Associate in Arts in Geography for Transfer (AA-T in Geography) degree prepares students to seamlessly transfer to a baccalaureate program in geography at a CSU. The program provides students with a well-rounded introduction to the

physical and social science aspects of geography as well as the technology and techniques used by professional geographers. Students working toward the degree will complete survey courses in the two main sub-disciplines: physical and cultural geography. Students will also have the opportunity to focus their studies on one of these subdisciplines or to continue a broad study of geography.
