- Successful completion of coursework toward degree

Historically black colleges and universities (HBCUs) have an excellent academic track record. While only about 17 percent of black undergraduate students attend a HBCU, over 28 percent of African-Americans who receive bachelor's degrees obtain them from a HBCU. These colleges and universities are also leading institutions in awarding bachelor's degrees to black students in the life sciences, physical sciences, mathematics and engineering. Thanks to an agreement signed March 17, 2015, between the California Community Colleges and nine HBCU's, California Community College students who complete certain academic requirements are now quaranteed transfer to a participating HBCU campus.

Numerous community colleges have already attended the HBCU Tour and it has been reported that some students are being ACCEPTED on the spot and some are receiving FULL- RIDE scholarships while on the tour. In preparation for this tour, please request your transcripts in advance. Bring multiple copies; they do not need to be "Official Transcripts", but if possible, bring a few official copies.
