			Dean Lobos brings back the idea of areas vs discipline courses, and the issue of
			consistency and fairness when identifying
			qualifying courses for SAA nomination. This has been an ongoing conversation.

Vento brings up the length of Honors Convocation when adding more to SAA list. Dr. Jaffe and Tamira share insights from past conversations inconsideration of the time constraints and program flow of the Honors Convocation.

To account for all subject areas with the limited 2 hours of Honors Convocation, it was proposed to remove the bio speeches of SAA recipients. Alternative program schedule was explored where SAA recipients can still be acknowledged such as having a second smaller ceremony like that of the AVC Foundation for scholarship recipients. Another idea is to have their bios marketed through AVC Marketing (i.e. TV screens, campus updates) AND for the honors convocation program to provide a link/OR code where bios can be accessed. No speech is said, but in its place is a bio accessible at an online/honors convocation location. All agree the nominating faculty is responsible for putting together the SAA recipient bio (what use to be the 1 minute speech). SAA memo still stands, but interpretation of areas is now applied across the board with ONE nominated student per area.

<u>Cap on Honors Courses at other colleges:</u>

How many courses will we accept from another institution? With increase of online courses (cvc.edu) similar thoughts were expressed by committee with honors option online classes. To be equitable, and not limit students and their choices, the committee expressed their support for unlimited honors courses to be taken at other colleges whether in person or online. If universities do not have a limit, then we should not either; and give credit as universities would. Honors TAP will highly "recommend" students to complete honors course requirements at AVC, but any taken elsewhere is accepted for Honors TAP completion.

Honors Option Online Classes:

Require all HO faculty to:

- Review their HO proposals for online pedagogy
- Make changes and present proposals to Committee if needed
- Agree that they will meet with students 6 hours over the course of the semester via zoom
- Only 1 HO online permitted

David brings up equity and access as primary reasons why HO online courses should apply towards Honors course requirements. If the online course is asychronous, then the HO credit for that class should be allowed (as long as it follows the HO online guidelines). Pavinee brings concerns with the challenges of online math classes.

To date, Grad list have been requested twice now from A&R and we are still waiting for "the list". SAA nomination deadline is March 28th.

Idea was presented to create an online platform where faculty must use credentials to log in to access list and do nomination form. Canvas? Report history of this of A&R Dean. This can be investigated for 2026 SAA nomination process. In lieu of timing, this year's nomination process will remain.

More to be planned in detail in next 2 committee meetings with changes of convocation.

Honors rebrand/Logo:

Draft of proposed logo was shared. Feedback was positive. Rachel shared keeping the colors as is so it is simple and not to distracting. Towana shares that simplicity was intended as printing on various textures and sizes with multiple colors can increase costs for production. If committee approves to move forward, Towana will forward logo to AVC Marketing for approval and follow next steps for print.

- I. Maintain membership in the AVC Honors Program (400 500 students).
- II. Review, revise, and implement the new Honors Option Contract System including faculty training and an Honors TAP Option Proposal Repository.
- III. Improve and maintain opportunities for students to complete Honors Options in needed and applicable areas.
- IV. Develop a marketing strategy/campaign for Honors TAP Promotion.
- V. Develop an Honors TAP Handbook for Students and one for Faculty.
- VI. Continue to focus on student recruitment through the maintenance of all student email access, recruiting in Honors classes, participation in outreach community events, and social media.
- VII. Maintenance of student TAP involvement via development of an honors student cohort through social events such as the Honors Program Mixers and Mid-Year Honors Student Check event.
- VIII. Maintain the Honors Ambassadors Program.
 - IX. 2025 HTCC/UCR Research Conference: Encourage Faculty and Student participation & attendance.
 - X. Increase course and option offerings in STEM and non-101 GE level courses.
- XI. Continue to hold the AVC Honors Convocation on a weeknight to encourage student and family participation in- person to celebrate Honors students, successful program completion, and Subject Area Award winners.
